Question: Who can participate?

Answer: Any Camper can participate.

Question: What are the rules for each act/performer?

Answer:

- 1) No more than 3 minutes much less for jokes and poetry
- 2) Prepared and ready to perform on arrival at Camp.
- 3) Only clean and pure language.
- 4) Does not minimize or glorify sin or evil things.
- 5) Only Camp appropriate content (positive and encouraging).
- 6) A performer can be in only 1 act whether it is an individual or group act. Exceptions can be made for those who are only accompanying or playing/singing backup for another performer.
- 7) Parents must know and approve the act, poem or joke.
- 8) Sign up on Sunday or Monday of Camp.

Question: Will there be an audition?

Answer:

- 1) Yes!
- 2) All acts will be auditioned for preparedness and Camp appropriate content. If you want us to give a decision as to whether the content is Camp appropriate before you take the time to prepare it, you can contact us. fdrycreek@gmail.com
- 3) Since we have limited performance time, the audition committee will choose the acts that can be performed in the time allowed.

Question: Any guidelines?

Answer:

- 1) Perform something that you know well.
- 2) For skits, have as few spoken lines as possible and remember to speak up.
- 3) Bring any recorded backup music already labeled with your name, the name of the song and its number on the disc or tape.
- 4) Lip syncing is for comedy acts. For all other acts, we want to hear your voice not the voice of a recording artist.
- 5) Because of limited time, no more than 1 joke will be allowed. So prepare your best joke.
